FOSTER AGREEMENT

I understand that and agree to:

- Provide the animal with fresh water, nutritious food, adequate shelter, any/and all medications it may need and a safe loving environment while it's in my care.
- Unless otherwise arranged, the foster parent is responsible for providing all food, litter, bedding, and toys for the animal while it is in their care at home.
- The foster parent is responsible for transporting the animals to and from The Humane Society

of the Uwharries and/or veterinary clinic for veterinary appointments, surgery, behavior evaluations, vaccinations, etc. The foster parent may also be responsible for transporting the animal to and from adoption events, and to off-site training classes, at the Foster Care Coordinator's discretion.

- If my living situation changes and I am no longer able to properly care for the animal I must immediately notify The Humane Society of the Uwharries.
- At no time can I relinquish my foster animal to anyone else other than The Humane Society of the Uwharries.
- That at any time The Humane Society of the Uwharries may come to my home to check on the foster animal's care.
- At any time The Humane Society feels the foster animal is not being properly cared for they may remove the foster from my home, and I will no longer be allowed to foster animals.
- The Humane Society of the Uwharries has the right to deny my application for any reason they feel necessary.
- The Humane Society of the Uwharries does not accept into this program those convicted of violent crimes or crimes involving animal cruelty or neglect.
- Although The Humane Society of the Uwharries takes reasonable care to screen animals for foster care placement, it makes no guarantees relating to the animals' health, behavior or actions.
- That I receive foster care animals at my own risk and can decline to accept any animal for which The Humane Society of the Uwharries has asked me to provide care.
- The Humane Society of the Uwharries is not responsible for any property damage or personal injury suffered by me, members of my household, including my own animals, or any third parties during a foster placement, and I assume liability to provide adequate controls to prevent such damage or injury I have read and understand the statements above.
